LIGHTING CASE STUDY

FSG Gets the Call for Site Lighting at Spectacular New Houston Botanic Garden

CHALLENGE

In Houston, eighteen years of planning and two years of construction were coming to an end at the fabulous new Houston Botanic Garden. The former golf course location had been painstakingly transformed into a world-class destination that would serve as a gift for America's fastest-growing, most culturally diverse metropolitan area. Netherlands-based West 8 had been tasked with providing the landscape architecture, and D. E. Harvey was the general contractor responsible for the ambitious construction project. When the job involved executing the extensive lighting design at the Botanic Garden, Harvey turned to FSG's Houston branch.

SOLUTION

In 2019, FSG began work on the site lighting project for the Botanic Garden construction project. Despite the challenges of working with non-traditional materials to create an outdoor space of this scale, FSG completed the project on time and with attention to detail. Site lighting, sidewalks, a welcoming boulevard, and additional hardscaping were completed by late 2020. The project was aimed at creating an internationally-renowned natural oasis in a growing urban area, and all parties delivered to the very top of their capabilities.

RESULT

The project was completed precisely and to the customer's ultimate satisfaction, and as expected the lighting installation for the Houston Botanic Garden conveyed the full impact of West 8's lighting design.
